

LEGAL NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS OF
SPRINGFIELD POST #32, THE AMERICAN LEGION

Notice is hereby given to all members of Springfield Post #32, The American Legion that pursuant to the By-Laws of American Legion Post 32, Article 14 Section 1 and the By-Laws of The American Legion Memorial Home Corporation, Article 5 Section 1, that on Tuesday, April 24, 2018, at the Post Meeting, which begins at 6:30 p.m. we will vote, at our headquarters, 1120 Sangamon Avenue, Springfield, Illinois on the following By-Laws changes to add the Junior Vice Commander as a member of The American Legion Memorial Home Corporation and The American Legion Post 32 Club Committee as follows:

ARTICLE TWO of American Legion Memorial Home Corporation BY-LAWS
Board Members and Meetings

Section 1. Members of the Board shall be limited to the Commander, the Senior Vice Commander, **the Junior Vice Commander**, the Finance Officer of the Post, the most-recent past Commander of the Post and three (3) members to be elected by the Post as provided for in the by-laws of Springfield Post No. 32. The Board shall elect a President and may elect other Officers as determined by the Board. All members of the Board must be a member in "good standing" with the Post. If a vacancy occurs on the Board, the Board members will be nominated and elected as provided for in the Post by-laws.

ARTICLE TWELVE of American Legion Post 32 BY-LAWS
Elected and Appointive Committees

Section 1. The Club Committee shall be comprised of the elected officers, being the Commander, the Senior Vice Commander, **the Junior Vice Commander**, the Finance Officer, the most-recent Past Commander and three (3) members to be elected from the Post in accordance with the procedures set forth in Article Eight above. The three members of the Club Committee shall be elected at the regular Post election for the terms beginning in 1996 and 1997 and every year thereafter as follows: Two (2) members shall be nominated and elected in even numbered years for a term of two (2) years, and one (1) member shall be nominated and elected in odd-numbered years for a term of two (2) years.
